Documenting Your Project on Hackster

Creating Your Project

Register for Hackster Accounts

- Each team member should register for a Hackster account at www.hackster.io and join the Biomaker hub at www.hackster.io/biomaker.

Create and Link a Project

- The team leader should create a new project and link it to the Biomaker page by clicking 'Submit a project' (top left of Biomaker hub), then 'Create a new project' (bottom).

Complete Basic Information

- Fill in the project name and elevator pitch sections and add a temporary cover photo. Save changes.

Add Team Members

- Switch to the 'Team' tab and add team members. You can also credit others' work here if appropriate. Save changes.

Add a Story

- Switch to the 'Story' tab and add a short description of your project. Save changes.

Publish Project

- Click 'Go to Project' then 'Publication Settings'. Fill in as much of the information here as possible, and set 'Privacy Settings' to 'Discoverable in the search and on platform hubs'. Save Changes.

Editing Your Project

Enter Edit Mode

- You can view and edit your project any time by logging on, clicking on your account (top right), clicking on 'My Projects' and clicking the edit button (top right of the project cover photo).

Document Components and Apps

- In the 'Things' tab you can add parts, components, software and tools used in your project.

Updating Your Story

- As your project progresses you should update your progress in the 'Story' tab.

Adding Attachments

- You can add code, schematics and other design files under the 'Attachments' tab.

Keep Your Project Up-To-Date

- Please keep your project up to date as you progress.
